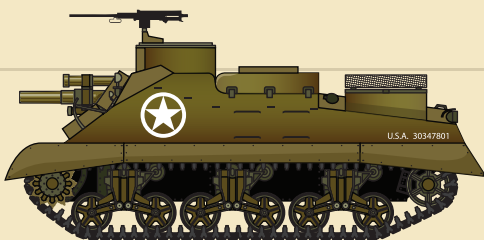
High speed artillery tractor built on the chassis of M2 light tanks

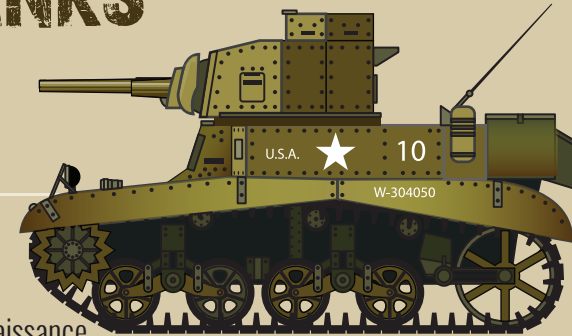

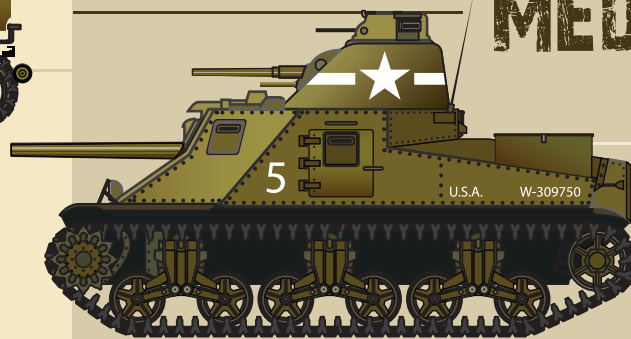


### M3/M5 "STUART"

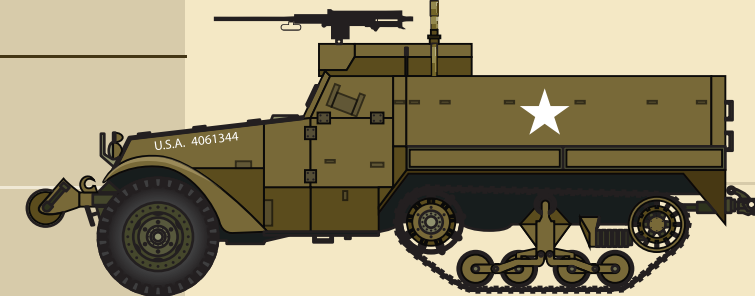

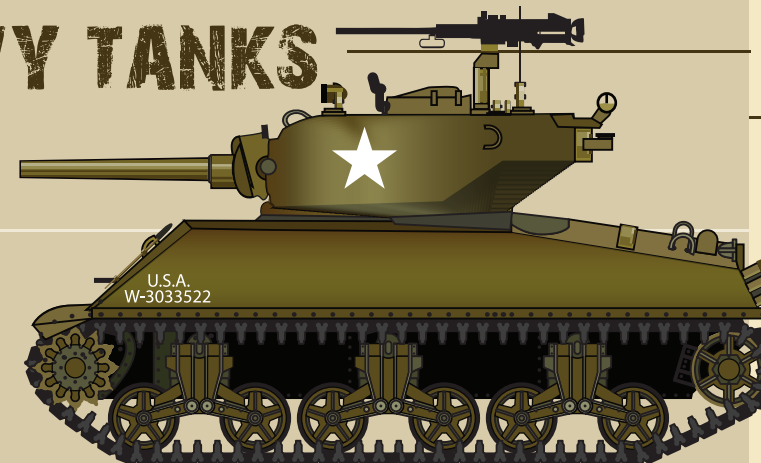
### M3 "LEE"

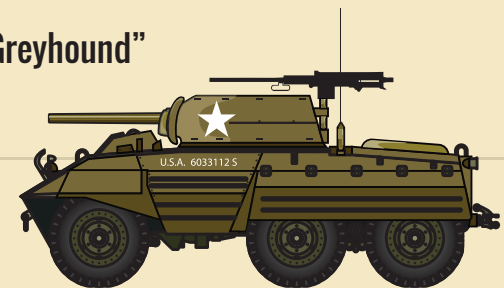
