

## CAF Pilot Scholarship Program Flow

Use the step-by-step guide to help understand the program process.

Step 1..... Candidate must join a CAF Unit & get involved.

Step 2..... Candidate completes necessary pre-requisites.

FAA Knowledge Test complete

Student Pilot Certificate (paper copy from 8710-1 works)

FAA medical (check flight school requirements)

Step 3.....Unit interviews with Scholar/Parents and makes recommendation.

Step 4.....Submit Unit application as the recommendation attaching student application

Step 5..... CAF HQ reviews scholar and CAF Unit applications and makes award

Step 6..... Funds will be Disbursed for scholar private pilot certificate training.

a. School will have received 40 percent of funding at this point.

Step 7.....Complete solo progress report.

a. Must complete first solo within three months of receiving award.

Step 8.....Disburse funds for scholar private pilot certificate training.

a. School will have received 80 percent of funding at this point.

Step 9.....Complete written progress report on Solo Cross Country.

Step 10.....Disburse funds for scholar private pilot certificate training.

a. School will have received 100 percent of funding at this point.

Step 11.....Complete checkride completion report. Have a party!!

a. Must complete flight training within 12 months of receiving award.

Step 12.....Determine use of excess funds if they exist.

a. If excess funds exist, up to \$1,500 may be used for future flying by the scholar if approved by CAF-HQ. (Tailwheel endorsement maybe?)

b. Excess funds must be returned to CAF.
